## HDPE/ Synthetic Viro™ 101

- ABOUT / CARE

Our High Density Polyethylene (HDPE) (by VIRO™) is an all-weather wicker designed for outdoor use and performs best in temperature ranging from -70°C / -94°F to 80°C / 176°F.

The synthetic fiber should not fade, crack or split even it's exposed under sunlight and rain throughout the year. **Protecting your synthetic wicker by using breathable furniture covers and or placing the furniture in sheltered environments extends the life of synthetic wicker.**

The synthetic wicker we use is made of High Density Polyethylene which is non-toxic (heavy-metal plasticizers free) and can be 100% recycled. Even when burned, no toxic substances are generated.

### Normal Care

- No extra maintenance is really required. To remove dust, simply rinse with water or clean up using a wet cloth.
- For tougher dirt build-up, use a mixture of equal parts water and mild-soap, then rinse with clean, cool water.
- To avoid water spots, towel dry if necessary.
- Do not drag furniture across rough stone surfaces. Doing so may weaken and or fray the synthetic wicker. Lift the furniture up with the assistance of another person to insure you protect yourself and the furniture.
- We recommend in extreme weather that you secure your furniture and protect it from being blown around or crashing into other hard surfaces, which could cause the synthetic wicker to crack or break from the impact.
- If you live in areas prone to strong hail, we strongly suggest that you relocate all your outdoor furniture into sheltered spaces. Strong hail can break or smash through synthetic wicker

- Jumping on and off furniture can cause the wicker to crack and or break. The wicker is not intended for this type of mis-use. It is also dangerous and can result in accidents and injuries to yourself and others around you
- Alcohol-based and oil-based cleaners are NOT recommended
