WE STRONGLY RECOMMEND USE OF HIGH QUALITY FURNITURE COVERS

The Seasonal Living® Cerulean collection is a weather resistant outdoor furniture collection manufactured from aluminum, powder coated frames with soft blue and heather grey acrylic hand woven webbed upholstery with fast drying foam and Dacron cushion cores and outdoor furniture cushion covers.

CERULEAN COLLECTION - PRODUCT CARE

To protect your furniture, follow these Product Care Instructions regularly – We strongly recommend that you purchase and invest in outdoor, breathable furniture covers and that you regularly clean and maintain your cushion covers from dirt, dust, animal hair, plant blossoms, pollen and other debris that can

present itself in the air during the year.

Care of Powder Coated Aluminum Metal Furniture Frames

- Wipe over the powder-coated aluminum frame with a soft, clean lint-free cloth on a regular basis – No abrasive sponges, scrubbing agents or caustic chemicals or solvents.
- Try to protect your furniture frames by avoiding abrasion or damage to the Powder coat.
- Do not use excessive pressure to clean the furniture frames – it is not necessary and may damage the furniture frame's powder coat exterior.
- If you chip or damage the powder coated frame, we suggest you consult with a repair technician or store to provide you with a barrier than be applied over the damaged powder coat to avoid rusting or further degradation of the furniture frame.

100% Solution Dyed Acrylic Soft Strapping / Woven backing and sides (Blue and Grey combination)

- Quickly wipe away spills and other staining liquids
- Vacuum the furniture with a vacuum brush attachment – be delicate when vacuuming - it is not necessary to exert too much pressure as you may damage or stretch the acrylic strapping. DO NOT use excessively powerful suction vacuums on the acrylic strapping
- Follow the weave of the acrylic strapping when spot cleaning and or vacuuming
- Should you wish to wash the strapping, use cool, clean water from a regular garden hose – Do not use powerful jet spraying hoses as this may weaken the acrylic strap / weave
- If the acrylic woven back and sides of the furniture become wet, allow them to air dry naturally. DO NOT apply any heating appliances to the acrylic material.

Cushion Care

One of the best ways to keep your spun polyester cushion covers are fade and water resistant. To maintain your cushion covers, be sure to regularly clean / vacuum and brush off any debris (for example: food crumbs, dirt, leaves, bird poop and pollen)

Wipe up spills or spot wash as spills and stains occur on cushion covers as they occur. Failure to wipe up or clean the fabric may result in staining

General or light cleaning: Brush off any loose dirt, prepare a cleaning solution of 1/4 cup of mild cleaning solution such as Woolite or non-colored Dawn dishwashing soap per gallon of luke warm water. Use a sponge or soft bristle brush to clean soiled area on cushion fabrics – allow the cleaning solution to soak into the fabric. Rinse thoroughly with clean water to remove all soap residue and allow covers to dry naturally. We recommend that when the cushion covers are slightly damp that you place them back on to the cushion cores – this will help reduce creasing and encourage a better fit to the cushion core.

Spot Cleaning: Using a spray bottle use mild soap (as described above) – Work the cleaning solution into the stain by lightly scrubbing the area with a soft sponge or soft bristle brush. Rinse the area thoroughly to remove all soap residue, blot up moisture with a clean, soft dry cloth and allow to dry naturally. Repeat 3-4 times or until stain disappears.

DO NOT APPLY BLEACH TO YOUR CUSHION COVERS

Machine Washing - Use the gentle fabric cycle only. Add normal washing machine detergent and 1 cup of regular household bleach. Allow the washing machine to complete its full cycle – Allow cushion covers to dry naturally. **DO NOT place cushion covers in any HOT drying machine.**

We recommend that you purchase breathable furniture covers that permit air flow on to the furniture and cushion covers. Plastic covers that do not allow good ventilation encourages humidity and can lead to mildew build up. Your cushion cores are made from fast drying foam. If the cushions become saturated with water, we recommend tilting the cushions vertically and unzipping the cushion covers and allowing air into the cushion covers to expedite the drying process.
