Our hand-hammered and hand crafted, copper Ingot collection, is made by a small group of craftsmen who have learned their craft by knowledge passed down through the centuries. Nothing in this collection is mass produced, while we try to follow similar dimensional information and aesthetic appearances, every item in this collection will be unique. This is due to your beautiful piece of furniture or accent being crafted by individual craftsmen where beauty is perceived through the eyes of the craftsmen. 1) STRICTLY FOLLOW ALL PRODUCT WARNINGS, ASSEMBLY
INSTRUCTIONS, OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS, USER MANUALS AND
NOTICES AT ALL TIMES. MAKE SURE THAT OTHERS KNOW HOW TO
SAFELY ASSEMBLE & USE YOUR NEW PRODUCTS. LOOK FOR THIS

2) ALL Tables are designed ONLY as a table to place light weight items & objects on. Tables ARE NOT designed to support any human weight. All chairs / stools MUST ONLY be used for sitting on by one person at any time. No rocking back and forth on

any chair or stool is permitted. NEVER USE ANY TABLE AND OR CHAIR TO STAND ON, JUMP ON / OFF AND NEVER USE FURNITURE AS A STEP LADDER. NEVER ALLOW CHILDREN TO PLAY ON, UNDERNEATH, INSIDE OR AROUND ANY OF THESE PRODUCTS

- 3) NEVER ALLOW CHILDREN TO PLAY WITH ANY PACKAGING MATERIALS. FAILURE TO FOLLOW MAY RESULT IN CHOKING, SUFOCATION AND OR BODILY INJURY

- 5) DO NOT exceed weights as shown on assembly instructions that are shipped with your product
- 6) Never Drag furniture. With the help of another able-bodied adult, move the furniture carefully and safely. Make sure if storing any furniture that you store it safely to prevent it falling on other persons. Do not permit children to play around stored furniture.
- 7) Do not sit on tables, chair arms, seat backs etc. doing so is unsafe use of the item. Failure to use chairs and stools correctly can lead to serious bodily injury.
- 8) Regularly inspect all products for cracks, or ripped metal parts. If any product is not in good condition, stop using it and remove it from use by others. Check your Limited Manufacturer's Warranty.
- 9) All furniture and decorative items ALWAYS to be placed on level surfaces.

Strong, direct & continual sunlight on metal can possibly cause the metal to become hot to the touch.

We recommend using this product in a more sheltered location away from long periods of heavy sunlight. Approach the merchandise with care to test if it is overly hot. If it is hot to the touch warn others. ALWAYS supervise children.

### FABRICATION OF YOUR INGOT COLLCTION FURNITURE OR DECORATIVE ACCENT

Each piece is supported by an interior structural support or skeleton providing strong, rigid structure for in or outdoor use. Each piece of the steel interior structure is powder-coated minimizing the chances of rusting of the steel support structure. Adjustable levelers are attached on the base of most items at the corners specifically in this collection allowing you to adjust heights and levels to create a stable surface on an uneven surface. Always make sure that each piece is perfectly level at all times. Levelers are adjusted by rotating the levelers on the base of each Ingot piece. Failure to create level / stable furniture or decorative items can lead to your merchandise tipping or falling and damaging the exterior copper structure and or causing bodily injury to you or to others. ALWAYS MAKE SURE THAT ALL FURNITURE USED IS PERFECTLY LEVEL AT ALL TIMES. Do not drag, pull or push any item in this collection. WARNING! Always use the help of another able-bodied adult to unpack, assist with lifting, moving or repacking.

#### **COPPER SKIN OR OUTER METAL SURFACE**

The exterior metal on your Ingot collection is a testament to fine hand craftsmanship. No two pieces are identical. Enjoy the uniqueness of each handmade piece of furniture or decorative accessory. Each Ingot item is coated in hand-hewn copper which is either dipped in other metals to provide a dazzling array or colors or finishes. Beneath the surface patina, is a sheet of copper. Copper by its nature is soft and malleable. This malleability of your copper item allows us to create the hand <a href="mailto:hammeredbeaten">hammeredbeaten</a> markings and appearance that enable us to create a unique pattern and or look.

Our Ingot Collection includes a finish and a sealant-lacquer (Permalac\$) applied for protection, nevertheless, this sealant-lacquer is just to protect the product from the weather elements \*\*

In order to keep your Ingot merchandise looking good for years to come, we recommend the following:

### Simple Product Care steps to take to protect your Ingot Collection Copper Product:

- When not using the decorative accessory or furniture item, use a breathable ventilating furniture cover.
- Protect against heat damage marks: <u>S</u>uch marks can become visible from placing hot pots or pans<u>directly on the surface</u>, ALWAYS use a

hot pad coaster or placemats (with a soft underside) for anything that comes directly from the oven or stove to protect the Copper and Sealant.

- Avoid the hot wax from candles; boiling water or any kind of hot liquids coming into contact with the Ingot merchandise item, this could damage the protective sealant / coating.
- Avoid leaving pieces of fruit such as lemons, limes, oranges, grapefruit, tomatoes or pineapple sitting on the top. The same for mustard, coffee, wine, salsa and vinegar, so make sure that any surface spills are always wiped up quickly. This will help avoid the appearance of white spots on any part of the metal surface.
- Avoid allowing food to come in direct contact with the surface.
- Using a soft, clean cloth, wipe up any spills immediately.
- After each use, please make a very quick and light wipe-down with a clean, soft cloth to remove standing water held on the surface.
- A table should not be used as a cutting or chopping board. The metal surface is not designed to withstand chopping and or cutting directly on the surface. When using forks, knives or other sharp utensils at the table, be sure to have dishes and placements on the table top to avoid scraping, chipping and nicking the metal's surface.
- Do not use any type of abrasive cleaners such as <u>S</u>soft <u>S</u>scrub, <u>M</u>.
   <u>Clean liquid or pads</u> or any chemical or ammonia-based agents to clean your Ingot <u>Collection</u> item.
- Always use the help of another able-bodied adult to help you pick up and move any Ingot Item.
- Do not drop or allow any heavy impacts on to or into any of the Ingot collection. Doing so can lead to metal indentations/dents or damage to the external surface and or finish.
- DO NOT write directly on to any of the Ingot metal surface. ALWAYS use a soft
  pad below any stationery or paper on to which you are writing. Writing on to
  paper with no protection can cause imprints in the metal surface.
- Always use a soft, non-abrasive cloth to lightly wipe or remove dirt and or dust.
- Paste wax polish also provides additional protection.
- Scratches and or dents to the copper may reduce the protective nature of the Permalac or lacquer coating

#### **HOW TO CARE FOR YOUR INGOT PRODUCT**

- Regular cleaning of the product should be done with gentle dish soap, a soft, nonabrasive clean cloth and warm water. Rinse thoroughly, wipe off any remaining water and allow to air dry
- b. Product Installed Outdoors will need regular attention and care. Rain, wind, sand, hail, snow and numerous other weather elements, will wear away at the metal, tarnishing and aging its appearance quickly. ALWAYS use a <u>breathable</u> protective furniture cover when not using the merchandise.
- c. In case your product has a sealant, we recommend re-applying a clear sealant at least four times a year to help maintain the original patina finish. Recommended brands: Clear Guard or Permalac.
- d. For further protection, consider adding a light coat of a high-quality wax which should be applied by hand each month. We recommend brands such as: Briwax, Renaissance Wax, W900-WAX or any other type of paste wax. Always test the wax on an inconspicuous area the first time you apply the wax. Should any discoloration occur, then do not add any more wax and contact the dealer where you purchased this product from for further assistance and support. When applying any of these waxes, apply the wax and then let the wax remain on the merchandise for 20 minutes, then using a soft, non-abrasive cloth, hand-buff to a brilliant shine.
- d.e. Do not use polishing compound, or equivalent for the surface, as this will remove the protective coating.

### PRODUCTS NOT TO USE ON A (COPPER, ALUMINUM OR CARBON STEEL) INGOT COLLECTION PRODUCT

- Chemical cleaners. Strong chemicals can eat away at finishes and cause negative reactions on surfaces. Products to avoid when cleaning your (C, A or CS) product include:
  - o Bleach, ammonia, rubbing alcohol and baking soda.
  - o Products manufactured for wood, tile or window cleaning.
  - Abrasive cleaners or Copper polish.
  - o Polishing compounds not meant for this purpose.
- Products that are chemically engineered to kill germs and bacteria. This can tear through lacquers and cause discoloration on the surface.

Any INGOT Product that is not cared for in the manner described in these Manufacturer Product Care Instructions or is abused or not used in the manner in which it is intended and or designed is not covered by the Manufacturer's Product Warranty.
