



Collection Products

Seasonal Living Perpetual Collection lightweight concrete products are handcrafted from raw natural materials. We begin by hand-mixing Portland cement, clean sand, crushed granite, and clean water with natural ramie fibers for reinforcement. The concrete is air-cured naturally in molds. Tabletops are then hand-sanded, colored, and waxed to achieve a smooth patina.

Features

- As handcrafted products, no two Perpetual tabletops will be alike.
- Finishes will vary depending on sand color, humidity levels, curing time, and wax finishing.
- A Perpetual product might include small light or dark spots, small hairline cracks, color changes over time. These are normal characteristics and should not be considered defects.

Care

- Apply the Concrete Protective sealer to your tabletop before using it. Concrete is porous and absorbs oils, acids, and chemicals. Re-apply sealer at least 3 to 4 times per year.
- Clean up spills immediately. Sealers provide only temporary protection against staining.
- Clean regularly with non-dyed dish-cleaning soap and clean, cool water. Apply with a soft cloth and then rinse with cool clean water. Mop up excess water and allow to dry.
- Avoid all cleaning products containing acetone, denatured alcohol, abrasives, bleach, or ammonia.
- Avoid contact with oily or acidic substances (such as citrus oil, citrus juice or olive oil), which can damage the sealer.
- Use mats and coasters to protect against stains and heat damage.
- Never cook, use heat, or place hot items on a tabletop.

Caring for Your Perpetual Collection Products

- For planters and vases, ensure that the drainage hole is clear and that water flows away from the container.
- Avoid using sharp instruments or writing tools on the tabletop without a protective pad underneath.
- Never drag a product across a floor or surface.
- Only use product under normal weather conditions.
- Strictly follow all manufacturer's product use instructions, care guidelines, product warnings, and other instructions supplied with the product.

We Recommend

- Use high-quality, breathable furniture covers to protect tabletops when not in use.
- Apply wax to concrete with a pre-moistened, non-abrasive cloth after the Concrete Protective Sealer has dried. Work in sections, massaging the wax in and then buffing it to a luster with a clean, soft, dry cloth. Allow to dry for 4 to 5 hours. Use a clear, non-dyed wax, such as SC Johnson Paste Wax.
- Avoid letting water or liquid stand on concrete tabletop. Wipe up spills immediately.
- · Always follow all assembly and safe handling instructions to move and install your table.
- Move furniture under cover during winter, if possible.
- If this is not possible, cover furniture with a professional-grade furniture cover and do not allow water to remain between the cover and top during freezing conditions.
- If the base comes into contact with ice and snow, we recommend raising the base a few inches off the ground.

Care of Metal Bases

Metal bases can be powder-coated steel or aluminum.

- Avoid impact to powder-coated surfaces. If the powder coating is damaged, the metal can begin to rust or corrode.
- Clean bases with dish soap and clean water and a soft cloth. Rinse and let dry.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, harsh chemicals, or brushes on any part of the base.

Care of Teak Surfaces

Table bases are made of reclaimed teak that was once used in boats or building structures. All teak bases are unfinished.

- Consider applying a professional-grade protectant, such as <u>Golden Teak Care</u> and follow all instructions.
- Dust regularly with a soft cloth or wipe with a damp cloth. You can also use a high-quality teak cleaner for thorough cleaning. Let dry for 24 hours.
- Keep flames, chemicals, grease, oil, and hot dishes off of the wood.
- · Wipe up spills immediately and use coasters to prevent water rings.
